# TIPS FOR SHARING THE ROAD.

Whether you're on a mission to get from Point A to Point B on foot, or in your car, or your mission is to soak up spectacular Colorado scenery on a Sunday bike ride, be respectful of everyone's rights to our roadway

You can help cut down on Colorado's pesky Road Hog population.

### Motorists

Focus on driving. Avoid using cell phones and other personal devices while driving. Keep your eye on cyclists and pedestrians. They have a right to use all the roads in Colorado unless expressly prohibited. Keep track of them in your rear and side mirrors. Slow down.

#### Pedestrians

Cross in crosswalks. Pedestrians have the right of way at crosswalks and intersections. Make eye contact with drivers before crossing to endure they see you. Walk against traffic.

#### Cyclists

Ride with the flow of traffic. Obey traffic laws-you're a vehicle too. To cross at a traffic signal that hasn't been triggered by a vehicle, go to the sidewalk and press the pedestrian push-button or bike indicator. Ride single file whenever possible.
