Key Findings



CTIO retained Corona Insights to survey Front Range Drivers in fall 2023. The goals of this research were to:

- Understand current attitudes toward Express Lanes.
- Discover what barriers to use exist for drivers.
- Compare perceptions between 2021 and 2023.
- Gauge awareness and support of safety enforcement efforts.




Positive Opinions of Express Lanes by Usage

Feeling safe while driving in the lanes next to the Express Lane








Traffic volume in the Express Lanes

Reasons for Not Having a Transponder






Barriers to Express Lane Use



Most drivers who had never used an Express Lane are very unlikely to use one in the next month.

Likelihood to Use Express Lanes in the Next Month (non-users)




Reasons for trying an Express Lane:

- To avoid traffic delays
- When 3 or more people are in the car to avoid the toll
- To avoid other vehicles when conditions are poor
- To make up time when running late
- To have a more relaxing drive

Enforcement of Express Lane Rules




Drivers in 2023 agree more strongly with all statements relating to enforcement.

Percentage of drivers who agreed that	2021	2023
People weave in and out of Express Lanes to avoid the toll.	61%	68%
Express Lane rules should be more strictly enforced.	58 %	72 %
Photo enforcement increases safety of all drivers.	73%	79 %
People will receive a fine if they misuse Express Lanes.	N/A	75%



Most drivers have no experience with fines or warnings for Express Lane violations.


Have you or someone you know ever received a fine or warning for misusing Express Lanes?






Nearly a third of drivers have heard of efforts to fine drivers for Express Lane violations.

Future Action Items

- Continue ongoing education on the Safety Enforcement Program to increase the number of drivers aware of the program.
- Focus education regarding tolling on what a transponder is and how it works.
- Continue the implementation of the Safety Enforcement program to increase safety in the Express Lanes.
- Review data on ingress/egress points and hours of operation for MEXL on a rolling basis to identify any proposed changes and address potential confusion on accessibility.
