Subject: Joint Service Update

Purpose:

To provide an overview of the Joint Service Legislative Report to the CTIO Board of Directors and Transportation Commission.

Background

In the spring of 2024, the Colorado General Assembly adopted Senate Bill 24-184. The Bill contains a legislative mandate to CDOT (including CTIO and CTE), the Regional Transportation District (RTD), and the Front Range Passenger Rail District (FRPRD) to work together to implement the completion of construction and operation of the Northwest Fixed Guideway Corridor, including an extension of the corridor to Fort Collins as the first portion of Front Range Passenger Rail. The presentation included as attachment A outlines the content of that plan.

Next Steps

All parties will continue to collaborate on more in depth analysis of this proposal to advance Joint Service implementation, providing regular updates to the Transportation Commission along the way.
