Since 2015, HPTE and CDOT opened Express Lanes on I-25, US 36 and I-70 in the mountains. Central 70, I-25 in northern Colorado and C-470 will soon add time-saving Express Lanes.

The Express Lanes are working for everyone — saving millions of Coloradans thousands of hours, whether they use Express Lanes or adjacent free lanes.



HPTE uses the Express Lanes to actively manage traffic congestion. Travelers in all lanes -- including the free lanes -- can see time savings of anywhere from 20-50 percent.

Any toll revenue generated from the Express Lanes can help to repay the money borrowed to finance their construction, as well as pay for ongoing operations and management.

LEVERAGING PRIVATE CAPITAL TO MEET PUBLIC DEMAND



HPTE will sometimes engage with the private sector to accelerate a project or transfer risks that are better managed by the market, as opposed to government. HPTE's private partner for US 36 assumes the toll risk while covering the costs of ongoing operations and maintenance, all while ensuring the roadway functions at the highest level.
