The <u>HPTE Annual Report</u>, substantially expanded with a readable description of the US 36 transaction, will be posted to the HPTE website today. A final copy will be filed with the legislature on 2/15/14 and will include any relevant updates from this point forward.</li> <li><u>The CDOT audit, (including audit for HPTE)</u> for the last fiscal year was published 1/17/14 and is available for inspection.</li> <li>Following the HPTE meeting today, all are welcome to attend the Transportation Commission workshop discussion on major projects for next year.</li> <li>There may be some legislative activity this year, including HPTE.</li> </ul>
US36 Report:	Director Cheroutes reported that the final documents, including the financial plan and issuance of private activity bonds (series, appx. \$20m) are being drafted. Offering documents for that transaction should be ready shortly thereafter, followed by a marketing period of 10 or so days. Once priced, the financial transaction will close. A good description of the process is included in the HPTE Annual Report. Chair Gagen noted that January 27, 2014 has tentatively been earmarked as a possible closing date and will be verified as we approach.
