Director's Report:	HPTE Director Cheroutes reported that HPTE has received invitations to participate in panel discussions on the progress being made on P3 projects and managed lanes in Colorado from the Brookings Institute, IBTTA Summit, and WASHTO conference. Director Cheroutes suggested that the time is opportune to reflect on lessons learned on the US36 project over the last 2 years and for implementing best practice recommendations on the process by which decisions are made (i.e., time schedules, financing) for future projects.

C470 Presentation:	Local community meetings have taken place over the last 1.5 years to study available options for C470 corridor congestion relief. Jaimison Sloboden, of Cambridge, presented on the C470 concept plan, comparisons to the US36 project, and traffic modeling aimed at improving mobility in the corridor through successful use of managed lanes.
