A wide variety of products and chemicals used in everyday life are hazardous and, if not properly managed, have the potential to contaminate the soil, water or air. Asbestos, lead-based paint and petroleum products are examples of the hazardous materials that CDOT encounters when acquiring land needed for highway projects.

CDOT identifies hazardous material sites during project planning in order to minimize the risk that these materials will affect project cost or schedule, as well as to minimize safety hazards affecting construction workers, roadway users, and the surrounding environment.
