Implementation of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 is guided at the State level by the State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO), who is appointed by the Governor. The SHPO advises and assists Federal agencies (such as the Federal Highway Administration) to ensure that historic properties are taken into account in project planning and development.

The Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) routinely consults with the SHPO when there is the possibility that a federal transportation project could affect an historic resource. The SHPO reviews CDOT's data regarding whether or not the resource meets the eligibility criteria to be considered historic. The SHPO also reviews CDOT's analysis regarding effects to historic properties



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
