



# Erosion Control Blankets



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## Erosion Control Blankets

One of the water quality Best Management Practices available for erosion control during CDOT highway construction is the use of erosion control blankets. These organic or synthetic blankets are installed on steep slopes or channels to prevent erosion until vegetation can become established. The blankets can be made of a variety of materials, including agricultural straw and coconut fiber. They are affixed to the ground using staples, pins or stakes.

Areas where a blanket is to be used should be properly prepared, fertilized and seeded before the blanket is installed. Maintenance is required to repair any damaged areas and any loosened or missing anchors.
