



Grading Techniques



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One of the water quality Best Management Practices available for erosion control during CDOT highway construction is the use of appropriate grading techniques. These techniques include soil surface roughening, terracing and rounding at tops of cuts, transitions and roadway ditches to minimize soil erosion.

This BMP addresses temporary conditions during construction. It must be used in conjunction with other BMPs such as mulching or the use of soil binders.
