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(Highway) improvements made by the Colorado Department of Transportation sometimes have impacts on wetlands. In cases where impacts to wetlands cannot be avoided, CDOT may need a permit from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers under section 404 of the Clean Water Act.

To obtain a section 404 permit CDOT must demonstrate that the discharge of dredged or fill material would not significantly degrade the nation's waters and there are no practicable alternatives less damaging to the aquatic environment. The application must also describe steps taken to minimize impacts and provide appropriate and practicable mitigation, such as restoring or creating wetlands, for any remaining, unavoidable impacts.



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
