The 280-foot wide landscaped bridge separates pedestrian and bicycle facilities from vehicular traffic, while providing space for a park echoing the feel of the nearby mountains. The City of Golden partnered with CDOT and the design team/contractor to take the RAMP funded project from concept to substantial completion in 3 years.

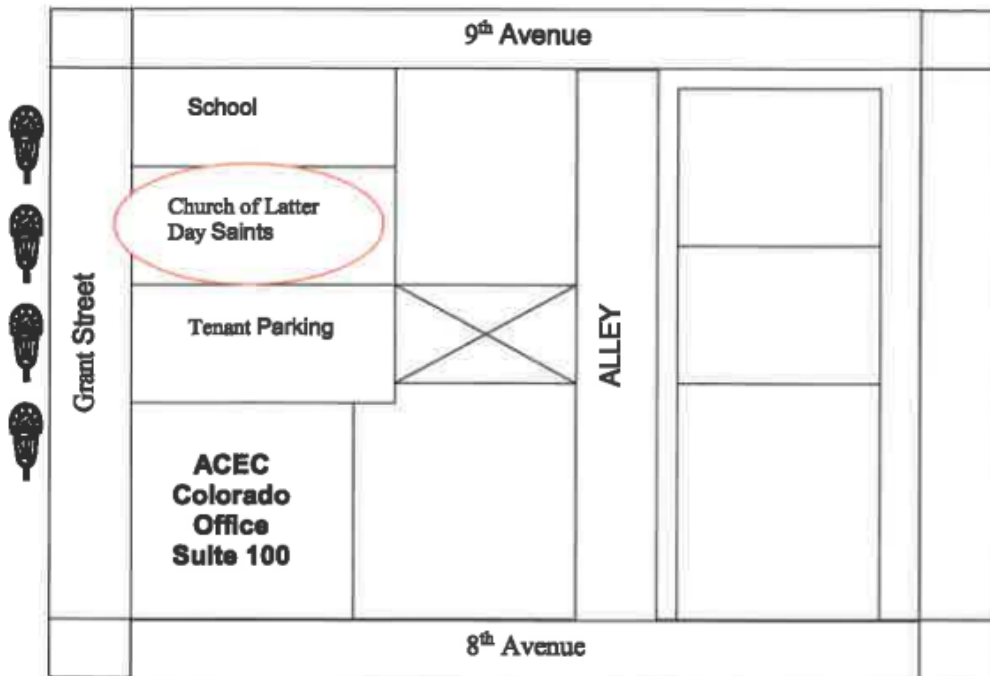
ACEC's office is located at 800 Grant St # 100, Denver, CO 80203
