Central 70 Express Lanes

Why Express Lanes? The Answer is Simple: Choice.

Express Lanes are always built adjacent to existing general purpose lanes and offer roadway users the choice to pay a toll, use transit or carpool for a more reliable trip. On CDOT's Express Lane corridors, travelers in all lanes (including the general purpose lanes) see time savings of anywhere from 20% to 50%. By offering choices, Express Lanes help to reduce delays, manage congestion and keep travel times reliable for motorists.

I-70 from I-25 to Chambers Road


Central 70, the I-70 corridor between I-25 and Chambers Road, is one of Colorado's economic backbones. It is home to 1,200 businesses, providing the regional connection to Denver International Airport and carrying upwards of 200,000 vehicles per day.

Corridor Basics

- 10 miles on I-70 between I-25 and Chambers Road
- Lanes are open 24/7.
- Dynamic tolling adjusts tolls as often as every 5 minutes based on real-time traffic conditions.
- Overhead signage indicates current toll prices. Tolls are collected through ExpressToll accounts or License Plate Toll.
- Free HOV3+, free motorcycle, bus and toll options are available.
