

## Why Express Lanes? The Answer is Simple: Choice.

Express Lanes are always built adjacent to existing general purpose lanes and offer roadway users the choice to pay a toll, use transit or carpool for a more reliable trip. On CDOT's Express Lane corridors, travelers in all lanes (including the general purpose lanes) see time savings of anywhere from 20% to 50%. By offering choices, Express Lanes help to reduce delays, manage congestion and keep travel times reliable for motorists.

## I-25 from Berthoud to Fort Collins

14 miles of Express Lanes span Interstate 25 from Berthoud to Fort Collins. With population growth over the years, the need for higher travel capacity has grown as well. These Express Lanes provide much needed relief to the corridor and additional choices for drivers. These lanes opened for testing with tolls waived in late 2023.

### Corridor Basics

- 14 miles from Berthoud to Fort Collins.
- Lanes are open for testing 24/7.
- Toll is waived while testing.

### After Tolling Begins:

- Overhead signage will indicate current toll prices. Tolls are collected through ExpressToll account or License Plate Toll.
- Free HOV3+, free motorcycle, bus and toll options will be available.
- HOV3+ users must have a Switchable HOV3+ Transponder and three or more people in the vehicle to use the Express Lanes for free.



