



Text Alerts Offer Updates on I-70 Mountain Corridor Travel Conditions

If your summer travel plans include driving Interstate 70 between Denver and the Western Slope, you can sign up to receive text message updates to help plan your trip.

The Colorado Department of Transportation will send text alerts specific to three areas along the I-70 Mountain Corridor:



- I-70 Floyd Hill Project east of Idaho Springs in Clear Creek County
- I-70 Mountain Express Lanes from Idaho Springs to Empire
- I-70 Vail Pass Auxiliary Lanes Project along West Vail Pass

I-70 Floyd Hill Project

Rock-blasting just east of Idaho Springs continues as part of the work to improve an 8-mile stretch of I-70.

I-70 Mountain Express Lanes

Crashes, roadway obstructions or other unforeseen incidents can cause sudden closures of the I-70 Mountain Express Lanes in Clear Creek County.

I-70 Vail Pass Auxiliary Lanes Project

Rock-scaling and avalanche fencing installation this summer will require intermittent weekday stops of I-70 traffic in both directions.

Text **floydhill** to **21000** to stay updated.

Text **xpresslanes** to **21000** to stay updated.

Text **vailpass** to **21000** to stay updated.

- + Text alert signups are all lowercase, one word.
- + Subscribe to one, two or all three text feeds. All messages will appear in the same message string, making it easy to track and plan ahead.
- + Text messages for Mountain Express Lane closures will be sent as needed. Weekly lookaheads for the I-70 Floyd Hill and I-70 Vail Pass projects will provide updates on planned traffic impacts, along with day-to-day reminders and traffic hold information.
