

# Regional Priority Investment Corridors

Rural TPR Regional Priority Investment Corridors were determined by each of the individual ten rural Transportation Planning Regions (TPRs). A Regional Priority Investment Corridor is a corridor that has been selected by the stakeholders of the TPR as having high importance to the region's transportation system, or it is important because of a need for near-term improvements. These corridors are the corridors designated by the TPRs as higher priorities for investment should funding for improvements be identified.
