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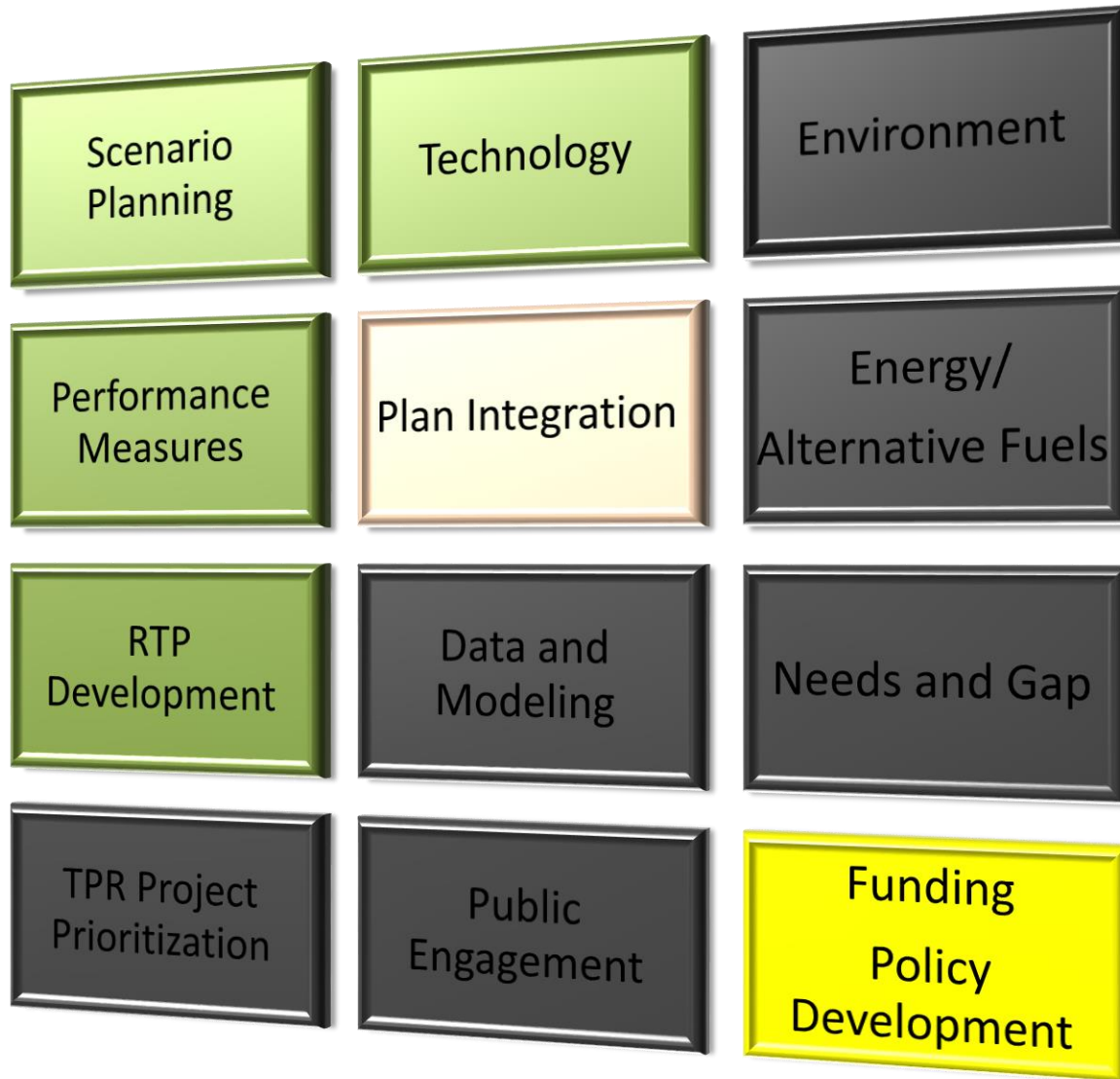
STAC Survey Results

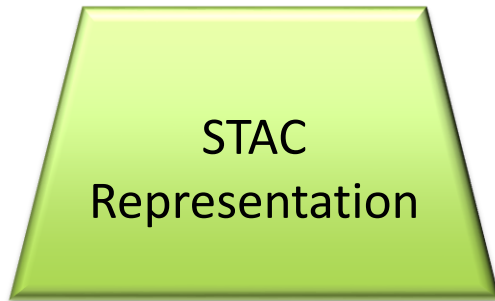

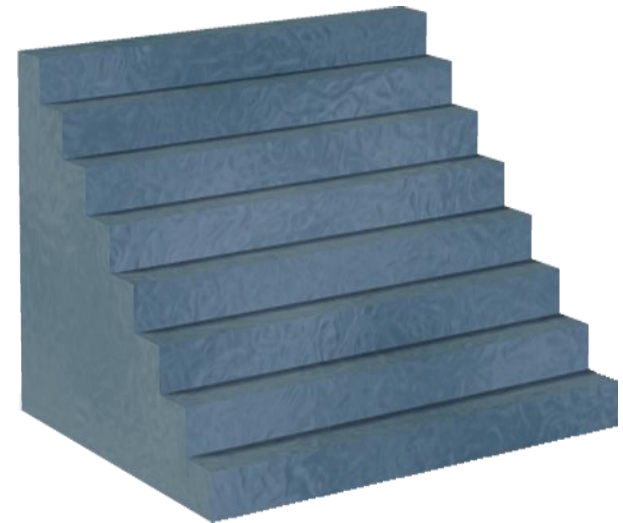




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Steps to Form a Steering Committee
