PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT

Public Involvement for the development of the FY2026 – FY2029 STIP is carried out in accordance with 23 CFR 450.210. Public involvement plays an important part in STIP development. CDOT’s Project Priority Programming Process, or 4P, has been established to meet and support federal requirements regarding the development of the STIP. Further, CDOT utilizes A Guide to the Transportation Planning and Programming Public Involvement Process as its guidebook for implementing public involvement for the entire planning process, including the development of the STIP. This guidebook is currently unavailable as it is being updated and made accessible for CDOT’s external website in late Spring or early Summer, 2025.

Public Involvement for the FY2026 – FY2029 STIP opened on April 27, 2026 and will close on May 29, 2026. Comments received will be detailed below.
