This project is in compliance with Colorado's Greenhouse Gas Rule 2 CCR 601-22.</p> <p>FUNDING: FY2024: \$1m SB267 funds FY2025: \$44m in SB267 and 10-Year Capital Investment funds. Additionally, CDOT has been awarded \$29,190,000 as a Federal INFRA grant to partially fund this project in FY2025.</p> <p>The project will reconstruct I-76 within its current lane configuration, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the reconstruction of approximately 1.45 miles of interstate corridor in both directions, - the replacement of four bridges over I-76 (two bridges on I-76 over the BNSF rail lines, and two bridges that pass over US 6 at its interchange with I-76), - the reconfiguration of the interchange with US 6, and - the installation of a Park-n-Ride mobility hub.
