Public Involvement for the development of the FY2025 – FY2028 STIP is carried out in accordance with 23 CFR 450.210. Public involvement plays an important part in STIP development. CDOT's Project Priority Programming Process, or 4P, has been established to meet and support federal requirements regarding the development of the STIP. Further, CDOT utilizes A Guide to the Transportation Planning and Programming Public Involvement Process as its guidebook for implementing public involvement for the entire planning process, including the development of the STIP.
