

CanDo Community Telework Program FY 2021 Projects Frequently Asked Questions

Who is eligible to apply for this grant?

Applicants must be eligible to be direct recipients of federal transportation funds. These include

- local governments and other governmental agencies,
- nonprofits, and
- transportation management associations/organizations (TMA/Os).

Private, for-profit companies (e.g., contractors, suppliers, or consultants) are not eligible, but may partner with other eligible entities.

Are matching funds required?

No match is required. While the committee will take matching funds into consideration for the Public Support evaluation criterion, applications without any matching funds are eligible for funding.

Is there a word limit for each question?

A few question boxes state character limits, but if a limit is not stated then applicants may use as many words as they feel necessary. Please keep in mind, the review committee is reviewing multiple applications each week, so concise applications will be well-received.

What type of projects would fall under the telework program - internal organizational efforts or outward community facing efforts?

Both - internal organizational efforts and outward, community-facing efforts - are eligible for these funds.

What transportation demand management (TDM) strategies should be used--are these local TDM strategies, DRCOG, CDOT or FHWA?

Any TDM strategies can be used so long as they align with the goal of the grant: to support any innovative ideas that help any workers (city employees or city residents) be able to telework more easily.
