Project Name	Project Description
Denver Area Arterial Street Pre-BRT and BRT Elements	Contribution for design and construction of (pre-) BRT elements (intersection and stop improvements/bike ped elements) emphasis on 9 corridors: Federal Blvd, North I-25, South Broadway, Park Ave/38 th Ave, Speer Blvd/Leetsdale Dr/Parker Rd, Havana, Colorado Blvd, Alameda, and E. Colfax. Other arterial corridors possible.
Castle Rock and/or Ridgegate Transit Station	Site selection, design and construction of a new transit station(s) near Castle Rock and/or Ridgegate.
Denver Heavy Maintenance Facility	Design and construction of heavy maintenance equipment facility in Denver region, shared by Bustang and Region 1's highway maintenance fleet.
Burnham Yard	Contribution (10% of bid) toward Burnham Yard acquisition (preserves option for realignment of freight and passenger rail lines).
Idaho Springs Park-n-Ride	Design and construction of expanded Park-n-Ride in Idaho Springs.
Fleet Purchases	New Bustang vehicles to support service expansion and new mobility hubs on South Line.

Project Name	Project Description
Bijou St. Maintenance Facility	Design and construction of new 10-bay Bustang facility located at Region 2 Vehicle Storage Facility in central Colorado Springs.
Colorado Springs Transit Center	Contribution to the construction of a transit center in downtown Colorado Springs to be served by Mountain Metro Transit and Bustang.
Woodmen Rd. Mobility Hub	Expansion and/or relocation of Bustang stop and mobility hub in Colorado Springs.
Monument Park-n-Ride	Design of slip ramps to improve bus service at the existing Monument Park-n-Ride/mobility hub.
Bustang Improvements	Stop and shelter improvements at the Tejon Park-n-Ride/mobility hub.
North Pueblo Mobility Hub	Land purchase, design and construction of new mobility hub in Pueblo with 100-200 parking spaces.
Outrider Improvements – Pueblo Area	Bus stops and shelter improvements at Pueblo West.
CRISI Grant Match	CDOT portion of Southwest Chief application for planning study to bring Amtrak to Pueblo and Colorado Springs.
Outrider Improvements – Southeast Colorado	Bus stops and shelter improvements at 8 locations: Lamar, Fort Lyon, Las Animas, La Junta, Swink, Rocky Ford, Manzanola, and Fowler.



Cripple Creek Administration and Operations Facility	Design of a new administrative/operations facility that will provide space for the transit division.
Fairplay Mobility Hub	Design and construction of new mobility hub and parking facility to connect existing routes (Gunnison-Denver and Fairplay-Breckenridge) along US-285.
Outrider Improvements – Central Front Range	Bus stops and shelter improvements at 2 locations: Cañon City and Cotopaxi.
South Central Storage and Maintenance Facility	Land purchase, design and construction of new bus storage and maintenance facility near Trinidad transit offices.
CRISI Grant Match	CDOT portion of Amtrak track improvements from Trinidad to the New Mexico border.
Bus Stop Improvements	Bus stops and shelter improvements at 3 locations: Colorado City Corners, Walsenburg, and Aguilar.

Project Name	Project Description
I-70B/US 6 Corridor	Arterial transit & bike/ped improvements on highest priority segment through Grand Junction.
Outrider Improvements	Bus stops and shelter improvements in Grand Junction.
Winter Park Maintenance Facility	Design of a new facility that will provide more maintenance space and covered overnight storage areas for vehicles.
Bus Stop Improvements – Northwest Colorado	Bus stops and shelter improvements in 4 locations: Fraser, Granby, Kremmling, and Hot Sulfur Springs.
Western Slope Storage & Maintenance Facility	Land purchase, design and construction of new Outrider storage and maintenance facility near Montrose (shared facility with All Points and/or CDOT Region 3).
Crested Butte Storage Facility	New 5-bay Outrider bus storage facility in Crested Butte (shared facility with Mountain Express).
Outrider Improvements – Gunnison Valley	Bus stops and shelter improvements at 3 locations: Montrose, Delta, and Gunnison.
Outrider Improvements – Telluride Area	Bus stops and shelter improvements at 3 locations: Ridgway, Placerville, and Telluride.
RFTA Aspen Maintenance Facility	Replacement of existing underground fuel tanks with new, double-walled tanks and monitoring systems.
Summit County Transit Operations Facility	Design of larger, upgraded facility necessary to accommodate all Summit Stage buses, support vehicles, and offices.
Frisco Transit Center	Design and construction of Phase 2 of the Frisco Transit Center project.

Project Name	Project Description
Longmont/Firestone/Weld County Mobility Hub	Design and construction of interim Bustang transit station at SH 119 and I-25 to expand existing Park-n-Ride from 116 existing spaces to 414 proposed spaces and add new southbound bus platform. Includes funds for land purchase to accommodate future center-median express Bustang station to be constructed as part of North I-25 Segment 4 for the ultimate Mobility Hub.
SH 119 BRT Elements	Contribution in support of RTD's commitment to provide BRT between Boulder and Longmont.
Bus Stop Improvements – Northeast Colorado	Bus stop and shelter improvements at Lochbuie, Hudson, Fort Morgan, Brush, and Sterling.
Fleet Purchases	Bustang and Outrider fleet purchases to support service expansion.
Centerra-Loveland Mobility Hub	Center-loading express Bustang station constructed as part of North I-25 Segment 7 managed lanes highway project. Mobility hub will be served by Bustang and City of Loveland Transit (COLT).
Berthoud Mobility Hub	Design and preliminary construction for a center-loading express Bustang station at I-25 and SH 56, constructed as part of North I-25 Segment 6 highway project.
Northern Colorado Maintenance Facility	Design and construction of new Bustang storage and maintenance facility in northern Colorado.
Harmony Rd. Park-n-Ride	Design for expansion of existing Park-n-Ride at I-25 and Harmony Rd. in Fort Collins.

Outrider Improvements – Southwest Colorado	Bus stops and shelter improvements at 5 locations: Durango, Mancos, Cortez, Dolores, and Rico.
Poncha Springs Welcome Center	Expansion and renovation of existing facility.
Outrider Improvements – San Luis Valley	Bus stops and shelter improvements at 3 locations between Alamosa and Buena Vista.
