

1,137 feet
- **5 Spans** **(151', 235', 378', 228', 145')**
- **Clear Spans:**
 - **Arkansas River & Levee**
 - **River Trail**
 - **UPRR & BNSF Yards (w/ pier between)**
 - **Loop Ramp Road**










