Fatal Crashes (2011 through 2015)

Fatal Crash Characteristics

13 fatal crashes occurred between 2011 and 2015 (approximately 2 to 3 per year)

- 70% occurred in dark conditions, compared to 33% of total crashes in the corridor
- 40% occurred on horizontal curves as compared to 13% of total crashes in the corridor, indicating potential to reduce crash severity with curve modifications
- 54% involved alcohol or drugs, which is higher than national averages (about 30%) and much higher than the 4% of total crashes in the corridor

Note: Numbers do not include preliminary reports of 8 fatal crashes (with 11 fatalities) in 2016 or the recent fatal crash on January 13, 2017.
