



## McCasin Boulevard On- and Off-Ramp Restrictions Crosswalk Installations Nov. 12-14

As part of the US 36 Express Lanes Project, work continues to complete the Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI) by the end of this year. The installation of the crosswalks is scheduled to start at the ramps listed below on Thursday, Nov. 12 -13, 9 a.m. – 3:30 p.m., and Saturday, Nov. 14, 4- 9 p.m. Due to the temperature-sensitive work, the installations must take place during daytime hours. The crosswalk installations will impact the three ramps listed below. Weather and schedule permitting, the ramps (shown in red below) will be closed at the noted dates and times. Lanes and ramps not in red will be fully operational and accessible.


**Thursday, Nov. 12, 9 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.**  
**Westbound US 36 off-ramp to northbound McCasin**  
**(the southbound movement at the ramp will remain open)**



**Friday, Nov. 13, 9 a.m.-3:30 p.m.**  
**Northbound McCasin Boulevard to eastbound US 36**  
**(access across McCasin will remain open)**



**Saturday, Nov. 14, 4- 9 p.m.**  
**Southbound McCasin Boulevard to the westbound US 36 on-ramp**  
**(northbound McCasin Boulevard to eastbound US 36 will remain open)**



Detours will be clearly marked and in place. RTD bus routes will follow the designated routes and schedules will not be impacted. After the crosswalks are complete, the ramps will be reopened, possibly earlier than the posted times. We appreciate your patience while we work toward finishing the McCasin Boulevard DDI. We understand that closures are an inconvenience to drivers and businesses in the area.
