


W. 120th Avenue in Broomfield to Close for Railroad Construction

Use Detours to Avoid Delays

W. 120th Avenue at the BNSF Railway tracks (commonly referred to as W. 120th Avenue local) will be closed from Monday, November 16 through Wednesday, November 25 for the creation of a temporary detour track for the BNSF Railway. W. 120th Ave. local will be closed to through traffic during this time, although businesses will remain open and residents will have access to their homes. Weather dependent, contractors will be working 24 hours a day to create the detour and complete the work as soon as possible.

During the closure, motorists will be able to access W. 120th Avenue west of the railroad tracks via Commerce Street. Motorists will be able to access W. 120th Ave. east of the railroad tracks via W. 120th Ave/US 287. Please see the map displaying the routes to use during the closure.

The detour track, known as a shoofly, will allow road crews to safely begin construction of the final phase of the 120th Avenue Connection/extension of SH 128. A new railroad structure will be constructed, and the tracks will be moved back to their current location when this phase of the project is completed in 2016.



This is the final phase of the multi-year

project. Earlier phases included the construction of a six-lane portion of State Highway 128 and a bridge structure over US 36. The final phase of the project will complete the construction of the new roadway that will connect SH 128 and W. 120th Avenue. Construction is planned to be completed in 2018.
