4th Street Bridge over Arkansas River, Pueblo, CO

Q: What is the history of the rail yard in the area of the subject bridge?

A: *Until 1921 when the concrete levy was built, the area that is now the railyard was part of the river channel. In 1922 the Rio Grande Railroad along with the Santa Fe Railroad built the rail yard. It has been used as a rail yard continuously since then.*

Q: Are there underground storage tanks or other storage of hazardous materials in this yard?

A: *No. I am not aware of any storage tanks or any hazardous materials storage at this location.*

Q: Have there been any spills, dumping or other events that may have impacted the area environmentally?

A: *No. I am not aware of any spills or dumping at the site.*
