

**Revisions to Section 250
Environmental, Health, and Safety Management**

Section 250 of the Standard Special Provisions is hereby revised for this project as follows:

Subsection 250.04(b) shall include the following:

“The surface of all steel structures coated with paint containing lead, chromium, and/or heavy metals shall not be cut by any instrument such as a cutting torch or a saw unless the paint is first removed”.

Subsection 250.04(c) shall include the following:

“The surface of all steel structures coated with paint containing lead, chromium, and/or heavy metals shall not be sanded or abraded unless the paint is first removed”.

Subsection 250.04(d) shall include the following:

The Contractor is advised that paint on structure K-18-Z has been tested for lead and chromium. The TCLP levels for lead on this structure exceed the regulatory limits of 5 ppm and is therefore considered hazardous waste. The Contractor is advised that a copy of the Bridge Paint Sampling Report is included in the Phase I ESA Report dated September 14, 2001 and is available from the Project Engineer.
