Final Design Completed for Interchange Reconstruction Project

The Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT), in partnership with Arapahoe County, the Cities of Centennial and Greenwood Village, and the Southeast Public Improvement Metro District, is proceeding with design of improvements to the I-25 and Arapahoe Road interchange. This project consists of replacement of the existing I-25 bridge over Arapahoe Road, and other changes to the interchange complex to reduce congestion and improve traffic operations and safety.

Over the past several months, CDOT has conducted extensive coordination with public, agency and utility company stakeholders. These conversations have shaped design details and moved the project forward to 90% design.

The design project's second and final public open house will be held on October 22nd to present the final design of the interchange and roadway improvements. Details of aesthetic treatments, construction phasing, and necessary property acquisition and easement locations will be displayed.

Following this meeting, any necessary final design plan revisions will be made and the related agency and utility clearances will be obtained. Construction is anticipated to begin on this \$68 million project in April 2016 and be substantially completed by the end of 2017.
