

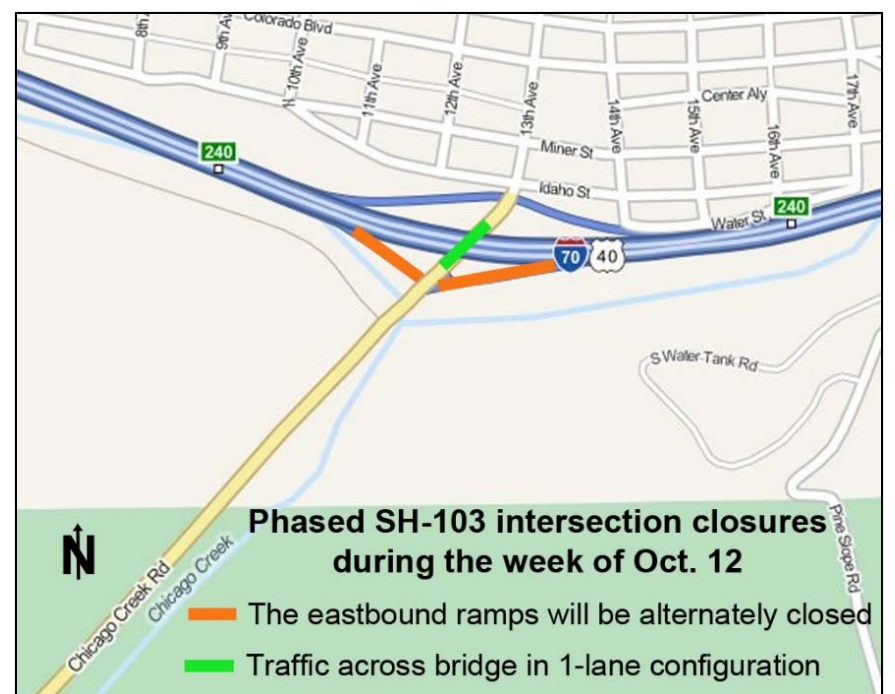


SH-103 interchange closures required for paving work

What: Now that the summer tourist season has passed, there will be weeklong closures of the on-ramps and off-ramps in the SH-103 (Exit 240) interchange and restricted access across the bridge over I-70.

When: The intersection on the north side of the bridge and the westbound off- and on-ramps will be closed Monday, Sept. 28, at 6 a.m. through Friday, Oct. 2, at 4 p.m. and again Monday, Oct. 5, at 6 a.m. through Friday, Oct. 9, at 4 p.m.

The week of Oct. 12, the eastbound on- and off-ramps will be closed alternately and the SH-103 bridge will be reduced to a single lane of travel for alternate work on the west and east sides of the intersection.



Details: If it is safe to do so, crews will open the bridge each night for travel over I-70. The westbound ramps will remain closed until Friday afternoon. Flaggers will assist pedestrians over the bridge during daytime hours.
