


## Weekend Impacts on McCaslin Boulevard Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI) Traffic Alignment Oct. 9-12

As part of the US 36 Express Lanes Project, a full weekend closure of McCaslin Boulevard over US 36 will take place the weekend of Oct. 9-12. This closure is necessary to align traffic into the new Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI) configuration. The full closure will be in place from Friday, Oct. 9 at 9 p.m. through Monday, Oct. 12 at 5:30 a.m. <u>Access over US 36 on McCaslin Boulevard will not be allowed as shown in red below.</u> During the closure, all eastbound and westbound US 36 on- and off-ramps to McCaslin Boulevard will remain open with right turn access only as shown in green below. Left turns and through movements from the ramps to access McCaslin Boulevard will <u>be closed during the alignment.</u> Alternate routes are advised. Local traffic is encouraged to use Cherryvale Road, 88<sup>th</sup> Street, or Interlocken Loop as alternative north-south routes to travel between Louisville and Superior.




• Northbound McCaslin Boulevard Detour Route:

Northbound McCaslin Boulevard traffic from Superior will be directed to detour onto the McCaslin Boulevard eastbound on-ramp to US 36. Traffic will then exit at Interlocken Loop, head northbound over the bridge, heading west at the Interlocken on-ramp to westbound US 36. Traffic will then exit at the westbound US 36 off-ramp to McCaslin Boulevard to continue on northbound McCaslin toward Louisville.



 <u>Southbound McCaslin Boulevard Detour Route:</u> Southbound McCaslin Boulevard traffic from Louisville will be directed to detour onto the McCaslin Boulevard on-ramp to westbound US 36. Traffic will then exit at Foothills Parkway, following Foothills Parkway to the Table Mesa on-ramp to eastbound US 36. Traffic will then exit at the eastbound US 36 off-ramp to McCaslin Boulevard to continue on southbound McCaslin toward Superior.



Drivers will need to be extra cautious when traveling on the new DDI for the first time. Traffic will be switched to the other side of the road and many of the lights will be removed, allowing free movements on and off of McCaslin Boulevard with yield movements. Once the weekend activities have been completed, there will still be miscellaneous construction activities through December at the interchange including ramp paving, sidewalk and median construction, and the bridge arch installation.
