


Weekend Delays Anticipated

McCaslin Boulevard and US 36 On- and Off-Ramp Closures and Restrictions

Saturday, Oct. 31-Monday, Nov. 2

As part of the US 36 Express Lanes Project, paving will take place on McCaslin Boulevard and at the on- and off-ramps this weekend. Different closures and restrictions will be necessary starting at 5:30 a.m. on Saturday, Oct. 31, through 5:30 a.m. on Monday, Nov. 2. The following movements will be restricted at the following locations and days for the final pavement surfacing and striping.


Saturday, Oct. 31



Ramp and Bridge Closures

- Southbound McCaslin Boulevard (across the bridge) from Dillon to Marshall Road (northbound access across the bridge will be allowed)
- Northbound McCaslin to the eastbound US 36 on-ramp
- Southbound McCaslin to the eastbound US 36 on-ramp
- Westbound US 36 off-ramp to McCaslin Boulevard

Sunday, Nov. 1



Ramp and Bridge Closures

- Northbound McCaslin (across the bridge) from Marshall to Dillon Road (southbound access across the bridge will remain open)
- Northbound McCaslin to westbound US 36 on-ramp
- Southbound McCaslin to westbound US 36 on-ramp
- Eastbound US 36 off-ramp to McCaslin Boulevard

Detour routes will be clearly marked, but alternate routes are advised. Local traffic is encouraged to use Cherryvale Road, 88th Street or Interlocken Loop as alternative north-south routes to travel between Louisville and Superior.

We appreciate your patience while we work toward finishing the McCaslin Boulevard DDI. We understand that closures are an inconvenience to drivers and businesses in the area. The paving activities must be completed prior to colder temperatures setting in, in order to complete the bridge by the end of this year.
