

TEMPORARY LANE CONFIGURATION AND LANE RESTRICTIONS Dec. 4-6

As part of the US 36 Express Lanes Project, the Colorado Department of Transportation will realign both eastbound and westbound US 36 traffic into a temporary split-lane configuration (shown below) this weekend starting at 7 p.m. on Friday, Dec. 4, and ending at 5:30 a.m. on Sunday, Dec. 6, to complete pavement repairs. Traffic will be realigned into a new configuration using the Express Lanes as a *free* general purpose lane.

To accommodate the traveling public and maintain two general-purpose lanes, all tolls will be waived only at the locations where the temporary weekend alignment is in place. Drivers traveling eastbound will navigate through the split-lane configuration from Interlocken to Wadsworth Parkway. Drivers traveling westbound will navigate through several split-lane configurations between 88th Street and Federal Boulevard. In addition to the split-lane configurations, <u>westbound US 36 will also include daytime left lane closures between Federal and Sheridan Boulevards.</u> Two lanes of traffic will be open at all times. All US 36 on- and off-ramps will remain open. Some delays and slowing should be anticipated and extra travel times are advised.
