



**Eastbound and Westbound US 36 Traffic Realignment
Between Davidson Mesa Scenic Overlook and Foothills Parkway at the South Boulder Creek
Bridge
May 2-June 30**

As part of the US 36 Express Lanes Project, traffic will be realigned in both directions starting at 9 p.m. on Monday, May 2. This alignment will take place approximately a quarter of a mile west of Foothills Parkway to a quarter of a mile east of the South Boulder Creek bridge (just west of McCaslin Boulevard). Traffic in both directions will have reduced shoulders and speeds to allow this phased work to begin. The number of travel lanes will not be impacted during this work with two lanes of travel remaining open at all times during daytime hours. Between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, and 10 p.m. and 8 a.m., Friday and Saturday, lanes could possibly be restricted to one through lane. This alignment is necessary for work on the approach slabs at the South Boulder Creek bridge, and is being phased over the course of the next two months. The anticipated schedule is below with the traffic lane configurations and new temporary alignment. Traffic will be shifted to allow for the additional phased construction that will occur through June 30. The phasing is as follows:

Phase 1 Work, May 2-15

- Eastbound and westbound US 36 at South Boulder Creek bridge
- Minimal impacts with narrowed lanes and reduced shoulders
- All ramps and general purpose lanes will remain open between McCaslin Boulevard and Foothills Parkway

Phase 2 Work, May 16-June 12 (tentative pending completion of Phase 1 work)

- Eastbound and westbound US 36 at South Boulder Creek bridge
- Eastbound US 36 traffic split into new configuration for median work zone (see below)
- All ramps and general purpose lanes will remain open between McCaslin Boulevard and Foothills Parkway



Phase 3 Work, June 13-30 (tentative pending completion of Phase 2 work)

- Eastbound US 36 (no westbound alignment during phase 3) at South Boulder Creek bridge
- Eastbound US 36 traffic minimal impacts with narrowed lanes and reduced shoulder
- All ramps and general purpose lanes will remain open between McCaslin Boulevard and Foothills Parkway
