


## ALTERNATIVES CARRIED FORWARD

#### SPLIT DIAMOND




- Splits Access To Two Crossroads
- Connects Blakeland Extension & Santa Fe With Parallel Roadways
- Increases The Number Of Signalized Intersections For Some Movements
- An Extension Of Blakeland Is Required

### 3 - LE VE L DIAMOND (A)



- Through Traffic Along Santa Fe May Bypass Interchange Intersections
- Reduces Congestion Within Interchange Compared To Diamond Configuration
- Geometry At Blakeland Intersection Will Require An Additional Traffic Signal Phase
- Potential Impacts T o S tate Park Land
- Potential T Ramp Access To / From Express Lanes

### 3-LEVEL DIAMOND (B)



- Through Traffic Along Santa Fe May Bypass Interchange Intersections
- Reduces Congestion Within Interchange Compared To Diamond Configuration
- Southbound Bypass Geometry Will Likely Impact E xisting Railroad Bridges South Of Blakeland
- Potential Impacts T o S tate Park Land
- Potential T Ramp Access To / From Express Lanes
