CO 7 PROJECT FACTS

Project Overview: The Colorado Department of Transportation and prime contractor, Flatiron Constructors, Inc., will conduct the following work on CO 7:

- After the 2013 flood, CO 7 became a major route in and out of Estes Park. Heavy trucks and increased traffic caused damage to the road. Twelve miles of two-inch mill and overlay will repair the damage.
- Approximately 40 culverts will either be repaired or replaced.
- Widening of the road will create at least four additional feet for new bike lanes, starting at Lily Lake and connecting to the existing bike lanes at St. Malo's Chapel on the Rock.
- In compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, and a commitment from CDOT to improve accessibility for people with disabilities across the state, several curb ramps will be upgraded in the town of Estes Park on CO 7. Existing sidewalks will tie-in to the new curb ramps at numerous locations.

Travel Impacts:

- Single lane closure with up to 15-minute delays
- Isolated full closures with up to 30-minute delays for rock fall mitigation and possible rock blasting
- Shoulder closures
- Sidewalk detours

Estimated Project Schedule:

- Work to begin the first part of May and go until October 2019 with a break during the winter months.
- Normal working hours will be from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday. In special cases these hours may be extended.
- In-town construction (MP 0.0 to MP 2.4) will not occur between Memorial Day and Labor Day.
