

CO 109A resurfacing project to begin in April

Resurfacing will take place from Mile Point (MP) 0 to MP 31 between La Junta and Kim

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Colorado Department of Transportation and contractor A&S Construction will be resurfacing 31 miles of CO 109A between La Junta and Kim. Work will include repaving, painting, guardrail replacements, and the improvement of safety features along the two-lane highway.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

Work is scheduled to start April 5, 2021 and finish in September 2021. Normal working hours will be from 7 a.m. - 7 p.m. Mondays through Fridays. The project will begin at MP 31 near La Junta and move south.

TRAVEL IMPACTS

- Single lane closures and shoulder closures will be in effect during working hours.
- Width restrictions of 12 feet will be in place during the project.
- Slowdowns and delays are expected.
- Please drive safely through the work area when crews are present.

PROJECT BENEFITS

- Updating the roadways through resurfacing, painting and guardrail replacements will provide extra visual and improved safety features along the highway.
- Rumble strips added near the intersection with US Highway 160 north of Kim will alert drivers to the upcoming intersection.
- Guardrail replacements at 14 locations will update existing guardrail to the recently updated safety standards to better protect vehicles in the event of a crash.
