CO 14 Pawnee Pass to Sterling Resurfacing Project

Traffic Update: May 22 to May 28, 2022

Work & Traffic Impacts: The project is located on Colorado Highway 14 Pawnee Pass to just west of Sterling in Logan County. The project limits extend from Mile Point 227.15 to MP 234.15, a seven-mile stretch of two-lane rural highway between County Road 21 and County Road 35. During this short holiday week, crews will work Monday to Thursday paving at the west end of the project and will continue full depth reclamation at the east end of the project. Single lane closures will be in place Monday to Thursday with pilot cars present to direct alternating eastbound/westbound traffic through the single lane configuration.

Motorists can expect:

- Eastbound lane closure will exist on CO 14 from Tumbleweed Drive to CR 35 (east end of the project) during working hours (7 a.m. to 7 p.m.) Monday to Thursday for full depth reclamation
- Westbound lane closure will be in place on CO 14 from MP 229-227 (west end of the project) during daytime hours
 Monday to Thursday for paving
- Pilot cars will be present to direct alternating eastbound/westbound traffic through the single lane configurations

Work will consist of full depth reclamation of highway pavement and paving.
