
SEPTEMBER UPDATE

We wanted to provide a summary to keep you posted on the activities completed to date and next steps on the CO 52 Planning and Environmental Linkages (PEL) Study and Access Control Plan (ACP).

PEL STATUS: The project team continues to advance the PEL concurrent with the ACP process.

Alternatives Analysis — The project team finalized the Level 2 Alternatives Evaluation Matrix, which included local agency comments. Based on the alternatives recommended and carried forward, the project team developed a list of potential future projects along the corridor (Project Categorization table).

PEL Report – The Project Team completed the first draft of the PEL and ACP reports. CDOT will receive this document for review at the beginning of October. Templates for a Letter of Support and/or Resolution were distributed to Technical Team members at the beginning of September.



ACP/IGA STATUS: An updated draft of the IGA (incorporating agency and CDOT comments) was submitted to the State Controller for review on August 31st. The IGA is on track to be completed and signed by all Agencies in November 2021.

COMMUNICATIONS: The project team is excited to announce that the Virtual Open House Event was a success! We received 1,041 unique website views, 237 Survey Responses, and 28 comments on the segment alternatives. The event ran from August 30th to September 20th. A Communications Packet with Spanish translations were distributed to the Technical Team to share and reach the maximum number of participants. A Public Open House summary is being created by the project team and will be included as part of the PEL document.
