



CO 52 & I-76 Hudson Roundabout

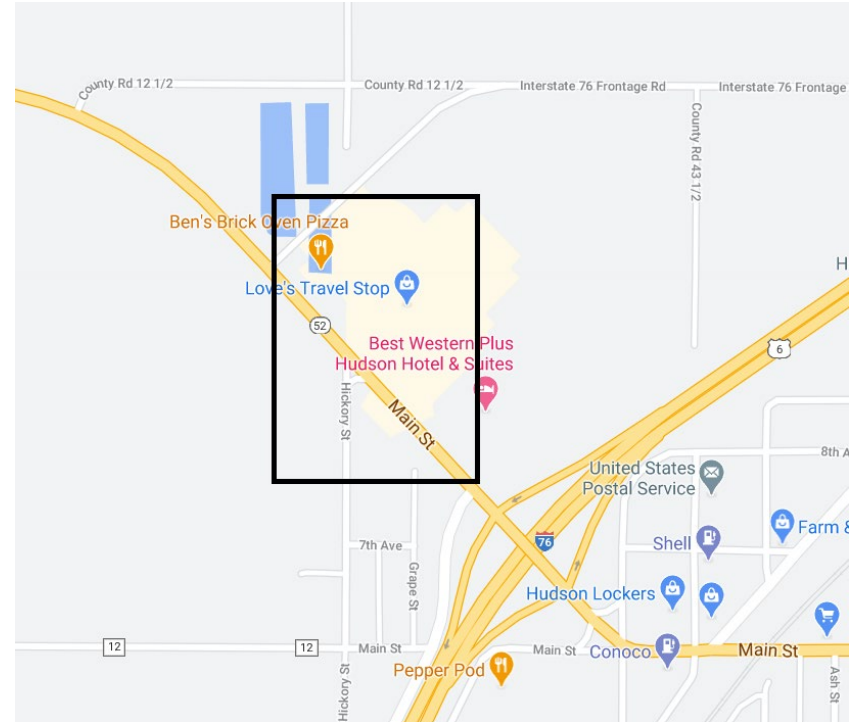
What Work is Being Done?

On Thursday, 9/3 CO 52, west of I-76, will be restriped and the eastbound lane will be closed. However, there will still be two lanes of traffic for east- and west-bound travel.

Starting Tuesday, 9/8 - 9/22, prep work and paving will occur on CO 52. While paving work, access to the business plaza will be detoured through the hotel entrance on CO 52. The I-76 Frontage Road west of Ben's Brick Oven will be one lane to exit only. A signal will be provided at the hotel entrance to help with the movement of traffic in and out of the business plaza while paving activities are in place.

Local traffic is advised to use CR 12.5 and CR 43.5 to avoid the paving area during 9/8 - 9/22.

This project will improve safety and access to CO 52 by installing roundabouts at the Love's Travel Stop and the westbound ramps intersections, a traffic signal at the eastbound off ramp, and the addition of sidewalk along the north side of CO 52 to increase pedestrian and bicycle connectivity. The bridge over I-76 will be expanded so that the sidewalk can be brought up to standard and incorporate a new bike path system. Work began June 1 and be completed by Fall of 2021. Castle Rock Construction of Colorado, LLC is the prime contractor for this \$11.7 million project, which will complete a corridor that safely moves vehicles, pedestrians and trucks efficiently.





Why is the work being completed?

This project is part of CDOT's "Whole System. Whole Safety." initiative aimed at enhancing safety for Colorado's traveling public. The intersection improvements will help move cars through the area efficiently and provide safer intersections and crossings for motorists and pedestrians.

When will crews be working?

Work will take place Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Travel Impacts

- Traffic will be maintained in two lane configurations on SH 52 to keep access to local business.
- Added traffic control devices may be utilized at Love's Travel Stop and at the off and on ramps (such as all direction stop signs or temporary signals) to aid in traffic movement.
- I-76 will at times be reduced to one lane in each direction and occasionally closed for ramp relocation and bridge construction.
