



CO 64 Meeker West Rural Resurfacing Project

Traffic Update: June 7 to June 13

Ongoing Traffic Impacts

The Meeker west rural resurfacing project will begin on Colorado Highway 64 at Mile Point (MP) 43, east of Rangely, and will continue for 18 miles to MP 61. Motorists can expect east and westbound one-lane alternating traffic, 20-30 minute delays, 35 mph speed limit, and 10 ft. width restriction during hours of operation.

Work will consist of constructing pads for guardrail end sections.

Hours of operation are Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.
