


Project Location/Detour Map

DETOUR OPTION 2


US 287 north to US 34 and US 34 west into Estes Park

HWY 34 DETOUR DELAY TIME = 25 ADDITIONAL MINS


River Realignment


CDOT PROJECT OBJECTIVES:

1. Complete the permanent repair phase of 2013 Flood emergency repairs.
2. Improve safety and reduce future US 36 closures associated with repetitive flooding to efficiently move people, goods and information.
3. Improve multi-modal safety by removing a blind corner at Mile Post 8 with rock blasting and increasing the size of the roadway shoulder.
4. Return the Little Thompson River to its natural channel alignment by installing culverts under US 36.
5. Add resiliency by allowing additional hydraulic capacity for storm flows and prevent future damage to the corridor serving Rocky Mountain National Park, Estes Park, and surrounding areas.
6. Install fiber optic cable infrastructure to prepare for the installation of safety cameras and cell phone service along US 36.

OTHER KEY NOTES:

- 1. US36 will be closed for major construction
 2. Detours are SH7 & US34
 3. Commute privileges for 5-mile radius neighborhoods only
 4. Commute windows; 7:00am-8:00am & 4:30pm-5:30pm
 5. To/From school busses allowed anytime during closure
 6. EMS, Fire & Police allowed anytime during closure
- 1. Expect single-lane closures 24-hrs, 7 days/week
 2. Emergency services continuously interrupted
 3. Fiber optic cable installation continues along corridor
- 1. Expect single-lane closures 12-hrs, 6 days/week
 2. Emergency services more quickly accommodated
 3. Fiber optic cable installation continues along corridor
- 1. All lanes generally open during daylight hours
 2. Some travel delays are possible for safe construction; flaggers will be on-site intermittently
 3. Fiber optic cable installation continues along corridor

Project Phases

Phase I (Approximate)

(Winter 2020 through Summer 2020)

- Rock Excavation (Blasting)
- Installation of Precast Box Culvert
- Construction of Temporary Detour Pavement after Box Culvert Installation
- Construction of Wingwalls for Concrete Box Culvert
- Installation of new Guardrail
- Complete Mill and Overlay of existing pavement
- Install Permanent Striping and signage.

Phase II (Approximate)

(Winter 2020 through Spring 2021)

- Installation of 14' Diameter Tunnel
- Rehabilitation of River Channel
- Installation of Wingwalls for Tunnel

Phase III (Approximate)

(Spring 2021 through Spring 2021)

- Re-alignment of river through new culverts
- Complete construction of Wingwalls on Concrete Box Culvert
- Install Final Seeding
