Construction Begins in October

When last September's storms washed out a large section of US 34 east of Greeley, it became clear that a better, long-term solution was needed to ensure the road could withstand a similar major flooding event in the future.

- CDOT built a temporary road around the area that was blown out by the flood.
- Construction will begin soon on a \$22
 million permanent fix to the road that will
 include a new bridge.
- CDOT officials and Flatiron will be on-hand at the public meeting to answer questions about the project. A brief presentation will be conducted at 6:45 p.m.
