ADA ramp improvements in Silt begin May 20

The affected roads US 6 (Main St.)

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Starting May 20, the Colorado Department of Transportation and Contractor KSK, LLC will implement ADA ramp improvements in Garfield County. Work will take place in Silt, on United States Highway 6 (Main Street and Lyon Boulevard) and will replace existing sidewalk curb ramps located at eight locations.

Affected intersections along US 6 (Main St.)

1st St. 3rd St. 5th St. 7th st. 9th st. Domebly Ct. 16th St. Lyon Blvd.



PROJECT SCHEDULE

Work is scheduled for May 20 and is expected to last until the mid June. Normal working hours will be Monday through Thursday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

TRAVEL IMPACTS

- Travelers by car, bike, wheelchair or foot can expect various lane and sidewalk closures where work zones exist, during daylight hours, Monday through Thursday.
- Sidewalks are likely to be closed overnight or over weekends to allow the concrete to set up.
- Access to all businesses will be maintained but may be temporarily altered.
