

ASPHALT PAVEMENT CRACK REPAIR



PROJECT OVERVIEW

On Sunday, October 10, the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) began repairing 14 segments of highway within six counties around the metropolitan area: Adams, Arapahoe, Broomfield, Clear Creek, Denver, and Jefferson.

The repair work, which is scheduled to last approximately through April of 2018, will extend the life of the roadways by approximately three years. The project will improve the safety and operation of the highway by placing heated sealant into cracks in and along the travel lanes of asphalt pavement and asphalt bridge decks to prevent water damage and slow pavement deterioration.

Interstate Sealant Inc. of Waukesha, Wisconsin, is the contractor for this \$1.3 million project.

PROGRESS

As of the end of November 2017, the project was 50% complete. Starting November 3, 2017, the project went into winter shutdown with plans to resume and complete work in Spring 2018. The following locations have been completed:

- I-25: 6th Avenue to 44th Avenue
- US-36: I-70 to Bennett, CO
- US-40 (Colfax): Tower Road to Sable Boulevard
- SH-128 (120th Avenue): Melody Drive to Federal Parkway

FUTURE WORK

Upcoming locations to be completed following project restart in March 2018:

- I-70: Eisenhower-Johnson Memorial Tunnel to Silver Plume
- I-70: Colfax Avenue to Kipling Street
- SH-128 (120th Avenue): Federal Parkway to Main Street
- US-285: Indian Hills to SH-8
- US-40: Berthoud Falls to Empire, CO

PROJECT IMPACTS

Motorists can expect minor delays as crews conduct mobile repair operations. The work will take place at night to minimize impacts to motorists. Work hours will generally be Sunday through Thursday night from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. No detours or extended full road closures are planned; however, motorists can expect single lane closures.
