



Access Management Plan

- The SH 9 corridor has an Access Management Plan which provides guidance for agency review regarding access permit applications and future access decisions. The plan should preserve and support the current and future functional integrity of the highway. The purpose of the access management plan is to achieve:
 - Improved traffic flow
 - Improved traffic safety
 - Reduced traffic conflicts
 - Provisions for appropriate access to adjacent land uses
- In some cases, driveway access may be limited to a right-in and a right-out onto the highway. This may impact driver behavior patterns and generate use of U-turns at designated breaks in the median.
