

CDOT to begin resurfacing I-70 from Georgetown to Empire

What is happening on the project?

On April 12, the Colorado Department of Transportation and Contractor partner, APC Construction, will begin resurfacing Interstate 70 from Georgetown to Empire. Work on this project will improve driving conditions and safety along this three-mile stretch of I-70. Work includes asphalt removal, asphalt paving, cleaning inlets, culverts, adjusting or replacing guardrail, roadway signing and restriping.

Where is the project located?

Work will occur on I-70 eastbound and westbound from Georgetown to Empire.

What are the expected travel impacts?

Travelers should expect overnight single lane closures and a speed reduction during work hours.

When are crews working?

Regular work hours will take place from 5 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday - Thursday. No work is expected to take place Friday, Saturday or Sunday nights or on holidays.

When should the project be complete?

This project is expected to continue into late October. The schedule is subject to change and weather dependent.
