


# I-70 Salt Wash Bridges Scour Project Fruita Riverfront Trail Detour



A segment of the Fruita Riverfront Trail will be closed 24/7 beginning Monday, Nov. 14 through the winter to complete necessary improvements on the I-70 overpass structures at the Salt Wash drainage along the Riverfront Trail. Trail users should use the detour route shown to safely detour the construction on the north and south side of the trail.

**Trail users traveling south on trail:**

A detour route is established at the intersection of the Riverfront Trail and the Fruita Bike Path to re-route users on the Fruita Bike Path to US 6 to CO 340 and finally to Raptor Rd.

**Trail users traveling north on trail:**

A detour route is established at the Riverfront Trail Access located on Raptor Rd to reroute users on Raptor Rd to CO 340 to US 6 and finally to the Fruita Bike Path connection to the Riverfront Trail.

The detour adds approximately 1.75 miles of travel and will cause commute delays. We appreciate everyone's cooperation in following the designated detour route.
