ROAD WORK AHEAD

EDWARDS INTERCHANGE PROJECT UPDATE May 24, 2010

Look for a slight change in the traffic flow at Berry Creek

-ACC will be adjusting lanes 8 feet on Berry Creek to accomodate work on the drainage area. Two lanes of traffic will still be available - just keep your eye open for this three week adjustment which will be identified with concrete barrier and cones.

-Traffic will remain on the west side of the Edwards Access Road and the south side of Miller Ranch road. Traffic has been reduced to one thru-lane in each direction (auxiliary turn lanes will remain).

- Work continues on Berry Creek, the walls at the eastbound I-70 on-ramp walls and the wall underneath the viaduct.

BASIC PROJECT INFORMATION

Project schedule: March 15 - November 19, 2010.

Scope: Construction of four roundabouts: Two at the I-70 interchange, one at Miller Ranch Road & Edwards Access Road, and one at the intersection of Berry Creek/Beard Creek Roads. Work also includes bike/ pedestrian paths along much of the corridor.

Traffic Impacts: There will always be one lane of thru traffic on Miller Ranch Road and the Edwards Access Road going in each direction during peak hours, plus auxiliary turn lanes. Peak hours are 7-9 a.m. and 4-7 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Funding: This project is funded by the American Recovery & Reinvestment Act of 2009
