- Crews continue to work on the Berry Creek realignment, walls under the viaduct and along the west bound off-ramp, installing conduit along Miller Ranch Road and preparing for temporary paving.

BASIC PROJECT INFORMATION

Project schedule: March 15 - November 19, 2010.

Scope: Construction of four roundabouts: Two at the I-70 interchange, one at Miller Ranch Road & Edwards Access Road, and one at the intersection of Berry Creek/Beard Creek Roads. Work also includes bike/ pedestrian paths along much of the corridor.

Traffic Impacts: There will always be one lane of thru traffic on Miller Ranch Road and the Edwards Access Road going in each direction during peak hours, plus auxiliary turn lanes. Peak hours are 7-9 a.m. and 4-7 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Funding: This project is funded by the American Recovery & Reinvestment Act of 2009
